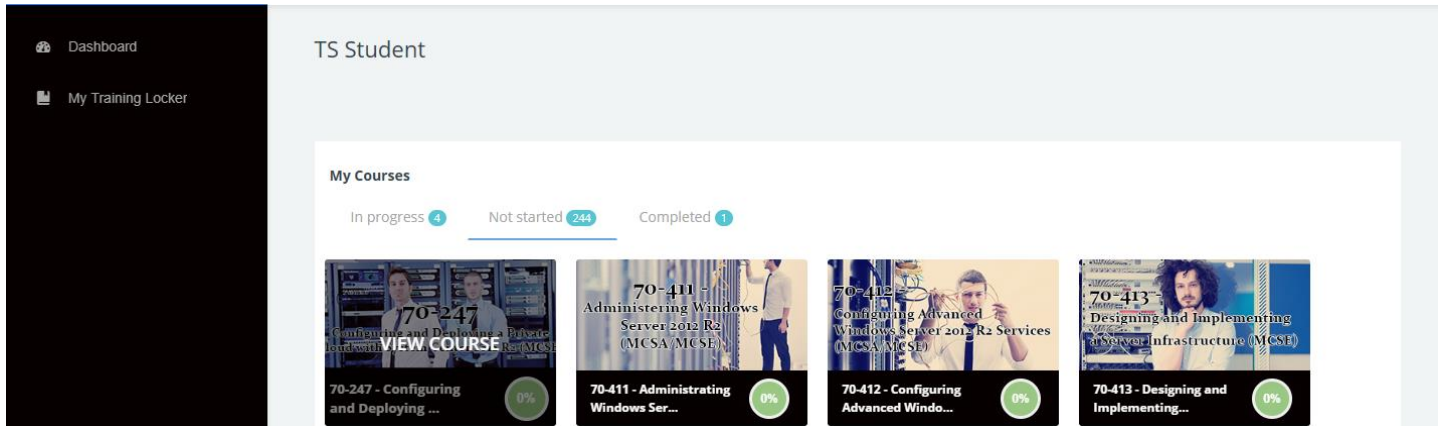
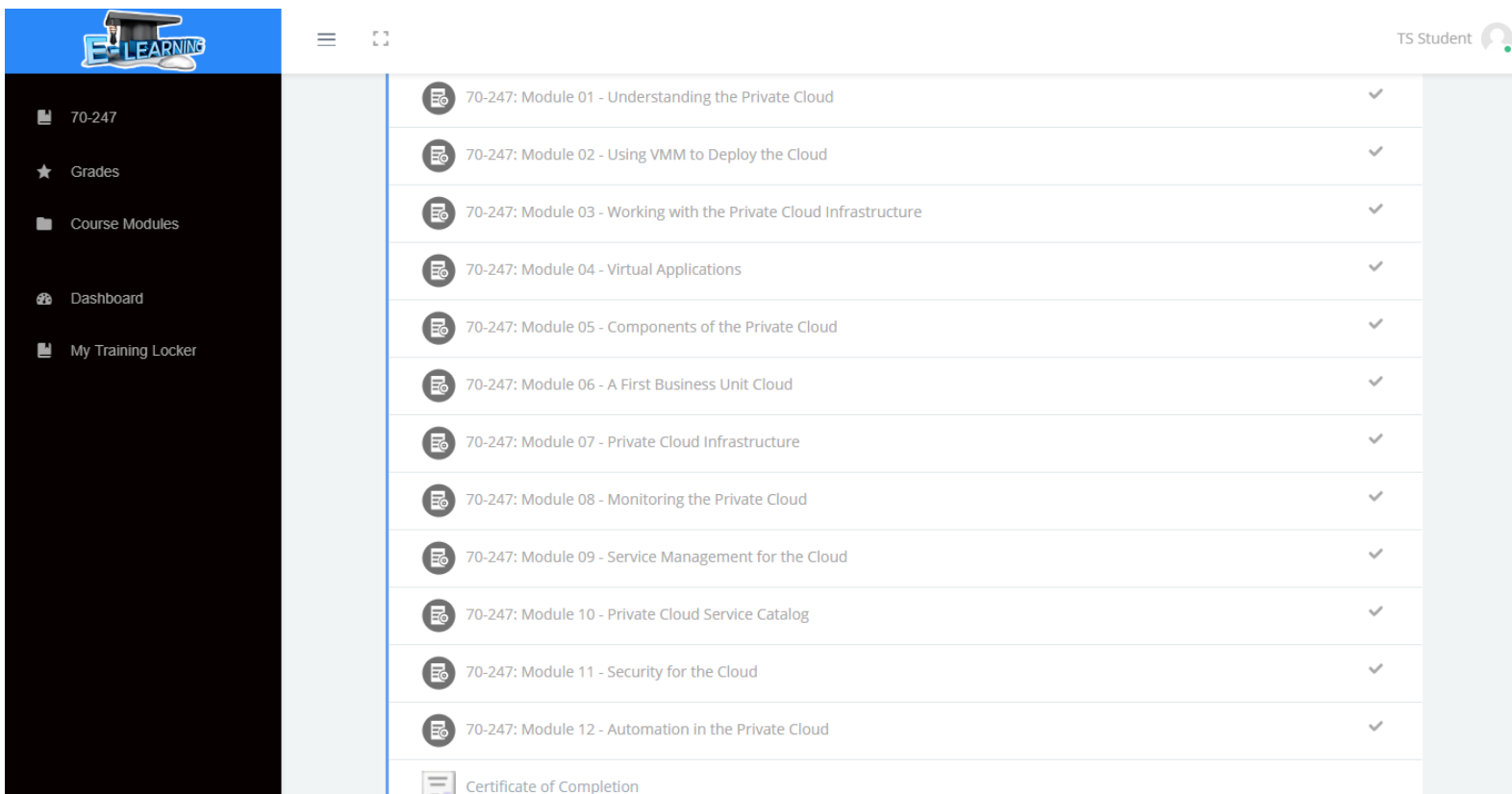


How to launch a course

If a user wants to access a course they have already started they can do so by clicking on any of the courses in the “In progress” tab. If they want to access a course they’ve never touched they need to go to the “Not started” tab. For this demonstration we’ll start with the course 70-247.



Once you select and click on a course, you will be brought to the courses main page. You can see this course as a total of 12 chapters. All of the check marks next to the chapters are grey signaling that the chapters have not been completed. Users can start at the top and work chronologically or they can bounce around from chapter to chapter.



Once a user goes through and completes all 12 courses, the check marks will be marked green and the certificate of completion at the bottom of the page will become available. Certificates can be printed out and downloaded as PDFs.

To launch a chapter a user needs to click on the chapters URL then click on the “Enter” button from the individual page.


